



# Instructions for Downloading Nassau Digital Doorway E-Books to an iPad or iPhone (two different ways to download— same results)

# iPad

## **Option A: Overdrive APP (No computer necessary)**

1. Go to your device's APP Store and install the free 'Overdrive' App. In addition, you will also need to obtain an Adobe ID (get one here: [www.adobe.com/cfusion/membership/index.cfm](http://www.adobe.com/cfusion/membership/index.cfm)).
2. Access Nassau Digital Doorway: Go to [www.franklinsquarepl.org](http://www.franklinsquarepl.org) and click on the Nassau Digital Doorway icon on the front page of the library's homepage.
3. Login to Nassau Digital Doorway (login button is located in the upper right hand corner of the screen) by selecting the Franklin Square Public Library and entering your library card number.
4. Use the search and browse options to choose your book (audio and/or e-book). When you have found a title you want, select "Add to Cart." If the title is already checked out, you may request it by selecting "Place a Hold."
5. After you have added an available title to your cart, select "Proceed to Checkout." Login by selecting the Franklin Square Public Library and entering your library card number. Select "Confirm Check Out" then "Download."
6. To access your book, return to your desktop and select your Overdrive APP. Your book will appear here. When the loan period is up (14 days for e-books, 7 for audio books) the book will no longer be playable on your computer or iPad/iPhone. However, it can be checked out again if it is available (not on reserve for someone else).

## **Option B: Transfer from Computer to iPad/iPhone (no sync required)**

1. Before you can download library books to your iPad or iPhone, you will need to obtain an Adobe ID (get one here: [www.adobe.com/cfusion/membership/index.cfm](http://www.adobe.com/cfusion/membership/index.cfm)) and install Adobe Digital Editions software on your computer. Here are two ways to access this software:
  - Go to [www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/](http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/) and follow the instructions.
  - Go to [www.franklinsquarepl.org](http://www.franklinsquarepl.org) and click on the Nassau Digital Doorway icon on the front page of the library's homepage. Once in the Nassau Digital Doorway site, click on the "Quick Start Guide" link located in the upper right hand corner. "Step 1" will instruct you how to install Adobe Digital Editions.
2. Make sure your iPad/iPhone has the latest version of the free Bluefire APP and an e-mail account that is accessible on your mobile device (you'll have to use the native mail app on your device—not a Gmail or other app).
3. Minimize Adobe Digital Editions software and go on the library's website ([www.franklinsquarepl.org](http://www.franklinsquarepl.org)). Click on the Nassau Digital Doorway icon on the home page or go to the database listings and search either alphabetically or within the "Audio and E-Book" subject category.
4. In Nassau Digital Doorway you can search for titles in the following ways: Entering title/keywords in the search bar; browse by format; browse by subject. E-Book titles will appear with format specific indicators (i.e. PDF, ePub, WMA, MP3).
5. When you have found a title you want, select "Add to Cart." If the title is already checked out, you may request it by selecting "Place a Hold." To see how many copies the library owns and how many people have holds on it, click on the title. After you have added an available title to your cart, select "Proceed to Checkout." Login by selecting the Franklin Square Public Library and entering your library card number. Select "Confirm Check Out" then "Download."
6. Transfer your audio/e-book to your iPad/iPhone:
  - a) Locate the file you have just downloaded (it has an extension of .acsm).

- b) E-mail this file (in the form of an attachment) to yourself so that you'll be able to obtain it using your iPad/iPhone.
- c) Using your iPad/iPhone, enter your e-mail and select the attachment. Have it open using the "Bluefire Reader" and choose the option "Read Now." When the loan period is up (14 days for e-books, 7 for audio books) the book will no longer be playable on your computer or iPad/iPhone. However, it can be checked out again if it is available (not on reserve for someone else).
