## RULES OF CONDUCT

The following activities are not permitted in the Library, the Library parking lot or surrounding premises:

- Smoking, including the use of electronic cigarettes
- Engaging in sexual activity or indecent behavior on Library premises
- Talking on cell phones (cell phones should be on vibrate when entering the building)
- Carrying a weapon into the Library
- Damaging Library property
- Stealing Library materials
- Physically harming staff or patrons
- Soliciting
- Disobeying the reasonable direction of the Library Director or the Director's designee
- Bringing animals into the Library except those needed to assist a patron with a disability, or with the prior authorization of the Library Director
- Misusing the restrooms (using as a laundry or personal washing facility)
- Leaving a child under the age of 11 unattended in the library
- Playing of audio equipment so that others can hear it
- Talking loudly, making noise, or engaging in other disruptive conduct
- Interfering with another person's use of the library
- Interfering with Library personnel's performance of their duties
- Sleeping
- Eating or drinking (including consumption of alcohol) from coverless vessels
- Inappropriate clothing (shoes and shirts must be worn at all times within the Library)

Library users who violate this policy may be subject to suspension of their Library privileges, exclusion from the library, and/or legal action. A copy of the Rules of Conduct is posted on the public bulletin board of the Library.
