We recently unveiled the Third Floor Meeting Space which has accommodated large events such as the Friends Luncheon, New Year's Eve Comedy Show, Book Sale, AARP tax assistance, and more. The additional meeting space allows not only the ability to offer more programs, but also more space for community groups. Furthermore, the Library now offers 3D printing which will grow into a Creation Space.

Even as the building becomes louder, busier, and more dynamic, we are also growing beyond our four walls. We are offering satellite library collections, services, and programming at our senior centers, nursery schools, parks, and local events. We are growing our digital collections to meet your demands and making the Library available 24/7.

We are thrilled to offer new services and programs with a minimal increase of less than \$3 per person.

Voter Information

VOTER REQUIREMENTS

Residents are eligible to vote if they are at least 18 years of age, a US Citizen, & a resident of the Franklin Square School District for at least 30 days prior to the election.

VOTER REGISTRATION

Voter registration shall take place year-round between 8 AM and 3:30 PM weekdays, when school is in session, in the District Clerk's office at the Washington Street School, except during the five days prior to any school district election. Residents who are registered may vote in any school district election if they; voted at or registered to vote for a school district election during the last four years, or are validly registered to vote with the Nassau County Board of Elections.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Absentee ballot applications are available on the website & the original form must be received by the District Clerk at the Washington Street School no later than May 14, 2024.

VOTE AT THE SCHOOLS (NOT THE LIBRARY)

Registered voters must vote at the building within their election district as determined by their street address.

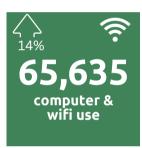

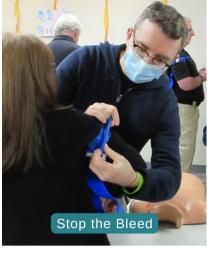

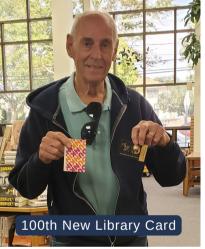
